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Quick Reference Guide

I. Clean and prepare the wound and peri-wound as appropriate. Consider the use of a skin barrier for peri-wound protection.



- Trim the dressing ensuring that it extends I cm beyond the edge of the wound.
- Apply the dressing to the wound assuring that it is appropriately positioned and aligned.



- 4. Secure the dressing to the patient using the provided Dressing Application Tape
- 5. Connect the dressing to the Delivery Port of the Fluid Delivery Unit.

- **6.** Fill the syringe with the appropriate volume of selected solution. Trim Dressing:
 - a. Less than 16 squares fill syringe with 10.4 ml.
 - b. Greater than or equal to 16 squares fill syringe with 12.0 ml.



- 7. Insert the Flow Activator fully into the pump to activate the unit.
- 8. Connect the Syringe to the Fluid Port.
 Position the Fill Port lower than the
 Delivery Port to purge air while filling.



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- 9. Expel the entire contents of the syringe slowly, filling the unit and providing a load to the dressing.
- Monitor the wound in accordance with standard clinical practice.
